-Al fresco lunch options around the ancient two thousand year old Pantheon including your search for the world's best authentic pizza and pasta dishes and Italian wine...






APRIL 11/SATURDAYROMA SACRAHOTEL DELLE MUSE/ROMEVatican City and St. Peter's Basilica will be the highlight of the day. A special tour has been
arranged for the ancient Roman catacombs underneath St. Peter's Basilica. This rare tour can
accommodate a limited number of visitors at a time so the exact days and times of the tour
will be announced while we are in Rome.

-Options include the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel -Other day trips can be arranged to the Villa Borghese Gardens and other major historical sites including the great pilgrimage basilicas of St. Mary Major, John Lateran and St. Paul's Outside the Walls— built on the site of the Apostle Paul's burial. -The final evening in Rome will offer an Italian feast at world famous: Da Meo Pataca with traditional music in the ancient Trastevere district.





APRIL 12/SUNDAY

PILGRIMAGE TO ASSISI

HOTEL LA DIMORA

Our short trip by coach takes us from the high energy of Rome to the quiet Umbrian hill town of Assisi. While tourists flock to its World Heritage sites during the day, we will be fortunate to spend three nights in the heart of the medieval town literally across from the Basilica of St. Francis, the 'universal saint' whose universal spirit pervades every corner of Assisi.

-After arriving we will have a firsthand tour of the medieval basilica built over the body of the humble saint and other highlights of 13th century Assisi

APRIL 13-14/MON-TUESDAY RETREAT DAYS IN ASSISI HOTEL LA DIMORA

Two days for personal R&R and a chance to explore the many unique options of Assisi from the Portiuncula chapel where Francis received his vision or a hike to the ancient Hermitage above the town where you can savor the same love of nature that inspired Francis and his contemporary, Clare (Santa Ciara).


-Breakfast and orientation each day followed by several destination options based on each person's preference and hiking abilities!

-During the ride we will begin to orient ourselves for the vastly different cultural experiences of Northern Italy and Austria.


-Hiking and picture taking in Switzerland offer up close encounters with these most spectacular mountains.
